We are pleased to announce the nomination process for two vacant positions in the **Society of Medical Oncology (SMO-P) Executive Committee (EC)**. The SMO-P ensures that the committee is composed of competent, representative, and ethically grounded leaders who can advance the society's mission.

1. Eligibility Criteria

a. Professional Qualification

- Must hold a recognized postgraduate qualification in Internal Medicine and recognized training in Medical Oncology (e.g., FCPS, DABIM, MRCP, or equivalent).
- Must be a registered medical practitioner with the national regulatory authority.
- Should have at least 5 years of oncology practice or academic experience post-qualification.

b. Membership Status

- Must be a regular (full) member of the society in good standing.
- Should have maintained continuous membership for at least 3 years prior to nomination.

c. Contribution to Oncology

- Demonstrated active contribution to oncology care, education, research, or policy.
- Preferably has published research, presented at national/international conferences, or contributed to society initiatives.

2. Ethical and Professional Standing

- No record of professional misconduct, ethical violations, or criminal offense.
- Must uphold the society's code of ethics and standards of professionalism.
- Must declare any conflicts of interest, especially with pharma or industry affiliations.

3. Leadership and Organizational Skills

- Proven leadership or administrative experience, e.g., leading departments, committees, or professional programs.
- Ability to work collaboratively and represent the society nationally and internationally.
- Commitment to transparency, accountability, and evidence-based decision-making.

4. Commitment and Availability

- Willingness to actively participate in meetings, events, and initiatives (minimum attendance requirement, e.g., 75% of meetings per year).
- Should be able to dedicate sufficient time and effort to executive responsibilities.

5. Election or Nomination Process

- Interested members should be nominated by another SMO-P member.
- Must consent in writing to serve if elected.
- Selection will be through voting by general membership.
